

The Current Symptoms

- Mass Unemployment
- Shrinking Middle Class / Limited Social Mobility
- Alarming Rise of "Zombie" Corporations
- Gargantuan (un-payable) Debt
- Geopolitical Instability
- Trouble Dealing With Natural Disasters

The Major Pathologies

- Anger & Disillusionment
- Substance Abuse & Suicidal Thoughts
- Rise in Violent Crime
- Reduced Adherence to the Law by Individuals, Corporations and Governments
- Reduced Social Cohesion

Some Necessary History

- Confluence of Major (Historical) Events
 - U.S. is ending its third Polybian cycle
 - Humanity is undergoing a *Third Industrial Revolution*
 - Resource base is *depleting*
 - Advent of the *Internet* levels the international playing field -- making income disparity harder to maintain
 - Widespread problems due to financialization

 - Three Phases
 - Dictatorial
 - Aristocratic
 - Democratic



Anacyclosis & the Constitution

- Because of the Constitution, we have 4 phases:
 - The Dictatorial
 - The Aristocratic
 - The **Democratic**
 - The Oligarchic
 - And it always ends in Crisis!

- A thing to remember about the Constitution
 - It does not set out a democracy
 - It sets out a republic
 - The two are <u>NOT</u> the same (and they never were)
 - Voting is merely the hope that you'll be represented
 - The battle over history has been <u>WHO</u> gets represented

Consequently, Americans are putting their faith in technology rather than people


That puts Privacy and Cybersecurity professionals on the front lines of the ensuing battles


Because the real battles will be in cyberspace over Encryption, Security and Privacy




A Framework for Understanding the Battlefield


- Pre-Industrial society is dependent upon raw labor power and the extraction of primary resources from nature

- Post-Industrial society is organized around *information*, for the provision of services




































The Likely Trends

- The Oligarchs are in a commanding position
 - (Historically) Oligarchs will fight to maintain their position regardless of the cost, even if unsustainable
 - The biggest asset that the Oligarchs have (for representation) are loopholes associated with artificial persons
 - Traditional Corporations
 - Artificial Intelligence in the form of Artificial Agents
 - Campaign Contributions (money as speech)
 - Revolving doors between government and corporations

The Likely Trends

- What can the Culture do?
 - Organize!
 - For that, they need communications
 - Not Facebook or Twitter
 - They are owned and centralized
 - They need **Decentralized** communications (Blockchains / Matrix)
 - They will need ENCRYPTION

 - Not corporations or Al



What does it all mean to me?


As a Privacy/Security Professional

- Thus, Software is going to be (more) regulated



As a Privacy/Security Professional
